Arvin Union School District is subject to the accountability requirements of the federal No Child Left Behind Act of 2001 for schools that fail to make “adequate yearly progress” toward meeting the state achievement standards. In accordance with those requirements, eligible students in grades 2 through 8 may receive Supplemental Educational Services such as tutoring outside the regular school day by a provider with a demonstrated record of effectiveness. These services are at no expense to the parents. The district is sending an invitation letter to all students currently enrolled in Bear Mountain, Sierra Vista and Haven Drive. Providers of Supplemental Educational Services (SES) are approved by the State of California.
